



## College Leap Community College Business Invitational (CCBI) Pitch Competition College Guide

CCBI Pitch Competition is an invite-only event, and thus only teams/individuals who are recommended by CCBI participating colleges can compete. Here are some general steps colleges/professors can follow to have your students participate in CCBI:

### 1. Become a CCBI participating college:

- a. The college needs to be an officially registered U.S. community college with 3,000+ enrolled students to qualify for CCBI;
- b. One full-time business faculty member needs to fill out this College [Signup Form](#) on behalf of the college (no fee will be incurred);
- c. A confirmation email will be sent within 5 business days once the form is approved;

### 2. Select a main contact person:

- a. Each participating college will be asked to provide a main contact person for CCBI to receive information and make student team recommendations;
- b. The contact information of the person will also appear on CCBI webpage for students from the same college to ask questions or seek recommendations;
- c. Only the teams recommended by the contact person will be recognized;

### 3. Recommend student teams:

- a. Each participating college will have 2 entries in the regional rounds;
- b. If your college has 1) a large student body (>50,000); 2) an outstanding entrepreneurship program; 3) multiple campuses; or 4) other reasons, and would like to have more entries, please contact us at [ccbi@collegeleap.cc](mailto:ccbi@collegeleap.cc) for more information.

### 4. Advisor Awards:

- a. Each national-round team's advisor will be awarded for CCBI Outstanding Advisor Award;
- b. National Top 3 teams' advisors will be awarded for CCBI Business Advisor of the Year.
